The respective HoD presented the executive summary of the curriculum placed for revision of

- M. Sc. Physics
- M. Tech. Computer Science and Engineering
- M. S. (by Research) Computer Science and Engineering

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1. Academic Council approved the revised curriculum of M. Sc. Physics which will be implemented w.e.f. Academic Year 2019-20.
2. Further, Curriculum of M. Tech. Computer Science and Engineering and M. S. (by Research) Computer Science and Engineering was approved with minor modifications as under
 - In second semester Technical Writing and Research Methodology will be offered as one single course with 4 credits.
 - Thesis credits will be increased from 15 to 18 in the IV semester.
 - Total Credits of both these programs will be 66.

The revised curriculum of M. Tech. Computer Science and Engineering and M. S. (by Research) Computer Science and Engineering will be implemented w.e.f. Academic Year 2019-20.

**Agenda Item No AC-A- : To discuss the matter of making minimum 10% of
57.03.02 Maximum Marks of End Term Examination
mandatory to pass a course.**

Academic Council accepted the recommendations of AC-AAC and decided that appearing in End Term Exam will be made compulsory to be considered for grading without making it mandatory for minimum percentage of marks for a student being considered for grading. Absence of student in end term will be marked as I grade and will be converted to 'F' grade by the instructor if make up is not asked for or granted. In the event of make-up being granted to and taken by the student, the grade earned will be awarded.

**Agenda Item No AC-A- : To consider the matter of assigning the same credits
57.03.03 even for the students opting for a course in elective
category for whom it is not a core course**

Academic Council decided that credits assigned to a course will remain unchanged when a course of one higher or lower level or from a different discipline is opted by a student under elective category. For example – if a 4-credit M. Tech. course is opted by a B. Tech. students as an elective, it shall be treated as a 4-credit course for B.Tech. as well.
