At the outset the Chairman welcomed all present and called the meeting to order

Thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for discussion.

**Agenda Item No. 1:- To consider the case of Mr. Sourabh Devani, an erstwhile student of the Institute, for his reinstatement/re-admission**

The Academic Council while taking a compassionate view on the matter observed that Mr. Sourabh Devani had cancelled his admission himself, therefore, he is no longer a student of the institute. Any request for admission to the institute can be entertained as per admission procedure of the institute announced annually.

**Agenda Item No. 2: To Consider the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Director to scout for alternate residential arrangements for fresh batch of UG Students, in the event of non completion of ongoing construction activities of Boys and Girls hostel on time.**

The Academic Council appreciated the excellent job performed by the committee in this regard. The Academic Council weighed various alternatives suggested by the committee and expressed unanimous view that to the extent possible all students should be provided accommodation in the institute campus itself, retaining the residential nature of the institute. Further, the Academic Council observed that shortage of students' accommodation is of temporary nature, as construction work is in progress and part of the construction work is likely to get completed in time. Part completion of construction work in Girls' Hostel combined with utilization of space in Guest House and a residential quarter and considering the estimated time of completion of Girls' hostel, it may be preferred to accommodate 3 girls in a room for a short period instead of accommodating them outside the campus in private or other hostels. However, the AC did not want to get into micro-management and desired that a monitoring committee, as to be constituted by the Director, should closely monitor the dynamic situation evolving and report to the Director periodically.

Finally, the Academic Council suggested that fresh batch of students may be offered the following three options from which one could select one for himself/herself for stay for a semester or part thereof.

- (a) Stay in a triple seated room
- (b) Stay with parents/ local guardians in the city
- (c) Possibly, stay in rented hostel

**Agenda Item No.3: To consider the request of Mr. Md Yaseen Feroze, Roll No.Y07UC066, seeking permission to register for three courses in the summer term-2011.**

The Academic Council deliberated on the matter at length. Taking into consideration the consistent improvement shown by the student in academics, the Academics Council allowed Md. Yaseen Feroz, Roll No. Y07UC066, to register for three Courses in the Summer Term-2011, as an exceptional case. The Academic Council further approved that Operating System and Mobile Communication may be offered as reading courses for the purpose. This may be considered as an exception rather than defining a procedure for future.
