The Roles and Responsibilities

1. The squad shall remain mobile alert and active at all times.
2. It shall be the duty of the Anti-ragging Squad to be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels and other places vulnerable to incidents of and having the potential of ragging. It shall be empowered to inspect such places itself also.
3. It will be the duty of the Anti-ragging Squad to conduct an on the spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Director or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or Guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person as the

case may be and the enquiry report along with the recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-ragging Committee for each action under clause 9.1 a) of UGC Regulations.

4. Anti-ragging Squad shall conduct search enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principles of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses took place before it the facts documents and views concerning the incident of ragging and considering such other relevant information as may be required.
